

TigerTronics Team Contract

Written: 6/8/2009

Dedication:

The regional and national competition trips will be paid for by the team provided you meet the following requirements:

1. Each member is required to work at least four days a week for a total of ten hours a week, and 60 hours over the six week build period.
2. Each member must attend at least 4 approved robotics related events, these events may include:
 - a. Mentoring a Lego League meeting
 - b. Attending a fundraiser
 - c. Attending a Robot Demo
 - The first four events that a student attends will earn the student \$50 towards their event fees. (see "Fees" section of this contract)
3. Students must be dedicated to their schoolwork as well as the robot. If a student's average drops below an 80 overall they will receive academic suspension from the team until they have proof of their grade's improvement.
4. Time requirements will be monitored by a sign in/ sign out sheet. A member must notify a mentor at the time they are arriving/leaving so their time may be initialed.

Effectiveness:

1. Each team member is expected to work efficiently on the tasks that they are assigned. They will be held responsible for the work that they are given.
2. Each team member will belong to a sub-team to which all of their work will belong. Every Monday and Thursday we will begin work with a meeting in which all sub-teams will report on their progress and discuss issues with their tasks.
3. Team members must take note of what they have done each day in order to prove that they have been working effectively.
4. Team members will clean up after themselves. No one else will be responsible for your JUNK!

Equality:

1. Each team member is expected to treat all other team members with respect.
2. There will be absolutely no insulting others.
3. Each student will be expected to follow the high school's code of conduct, as well as the TigerTronics code of conduct, while working on the robot, or while at any competition.
4. Mentors will be responsible for determining when an equality requirement has been infringed.

Punctuality:

1. Each student must show up to meetings on time, or else they must let a mentor, or a leader, know if they will be late or cannot come.
2. Each student must finish their tasks on time and do their best to follow the work schedule that is established. If problems arise and the task cannot be finished on time, the student is expected to update team members on their status and do the best they can to get the task done.

Fees

1. Every team member will start the season owing a \$200 event fee. Each time they attend an approved robotics event they will receive a \$50 credit towards the event fee.
 2. Infractions of the rules will result in the fees seen in the "Rule Infractions" section of this contract.
- Note: By attending 4 approved robotics events("Dedication" Point: 2), and by not infracting upon any rules set down in this contract, it is possible to owe absolutely nothing to the team besides hard work!

Rule Infractions:

All infraction of the rules will result in the following fees:

Infraction	Cost per Infraction
Don't make weekly ten hours	\$20
Ineffective weekly ten hours	\$20
Leave a mess after leaving	\$10
Break an equality requirement	\$20
Serious Ethics or Safety Violation	To be determined by Mrs. Daugherty

Every team member will start the season owing a \$200 event fee. Each time they attend an approved robotics event they will receive a \$50 credit towards the event fee.

- Although any mentor may make note of a rule infraction, Mrs. Daugherty will have the final vote on whether a fee is imposed or not.
- To go on the trips all fees must be paid in full.
